

Biblical 'one anothers'

Love one another

(John 13:34 NASB) "A new commandment I give to you, that you **love one another**, even as I have loved you, that you also **love one another**."

(John 13:35 NASB) "By this all men will know that you are My disciples, if you have **love for one another**."

(John 15:12 NASB) "This is My commandment, that you **love one another**, just as I have loved you."

(John 15:17 NASB) "This I command you, that you **love one another**."

(Rom 13:8 NASB) Owe nothing to anyone except to **love one another**; for he who loves his neighbor has fulfilled the law.

(1 Th 4:9 NASB) Now as to the love of the brethren, you have no need for anyone to write to you, for you yourselves are taught by God to **love one another**;

(2 Th 1:3 NASB) We ought always to give thanks to God for you, brethren, as is only fitting, because your faith is greatly enlarged, and the **love** of each one of you toward **one another** grows ever greater;

(1 Pet 1:22 NASB) Since you have in obedience to the truth purified your souls for a sincere love of the brethren, fervently **love one another** from the heart,

(1 Pet 4:8 NASB) Above all, keep fervent in your **love for one another**, because love covers a multitude of sins.

(1 John 3:11 NASB) For this is the message which you have heard from the beginning, that we should **love one another**;

(1 John 3:23 NASB) And this is His commandment, that we believe in the name of His Son Jesus Christ, and **love one another**, just as He commanded us.

(1 John 4:7 NASB) Beloved, let us **love one another**, for love is from God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God.

(1 John 4:11 NASB) Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to **love one another**."

(1 John 4:12 NASB) No one has beheld God at any time; if we **love one another**, God abides in us, and His love is perfected in us.

(2 John 1:5 NASB) And now I ask you, lady, not as writing to you a new commandment, but the one which we have had from the beginning, that we **love one another**."

...one another

(Mark 9:50 NASB) "Salt is good; but if the salt becomes unsalty, with what will you make it salty again? Have salt in yourselves, and **be at peace with one another**."

(Rom 12:10 NASB) **Be devoted to one another** in brotherly love; **give preference to one another** in honor;

(Rom 12:16 NASB) **Be of the same mind toward one another**; do not be haughty in mind, but associate with the lowly. Do not be wise in your own estimation.

(Rom 14:13 NASB) Therefore **let us not judge one another** anymore, but rather determine this-- not to put an obstacle or a stumbling block in a brother's way.

(Rom 14:19 NASB) So then let us pursue the things which make for peace and the **building up of one another**."

(Rom 15:5 NASB) Now may the God who gives perseverance and encouragement grant you to **be of the same mind with one another** according to Christ Jesus;

(Rom 15:7 NASB) Wherefore, **accept one another**, just as Christ also accepted us to the glory of God.

Biblical 'one anothers'

(Rom 15:14 NASB) And concerning you, my brethren, I myself also am convinced that you yourselves are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge, and able also to **admonish one another**.

(1 Cor 11:33 NASB) So then, my brethren, when you come together to eat, **wait for one another**.

(1 Cor 12:25 NASB) that there should be no division in the body, but that the members should **have the same care for one another**.

(1 Cor 6:7 NASB) Actually, then, it is already a defeat for you, that you have lawsuits with **one another**. Why not **rather be wronged**? Why not **rather be defrauded**?

(Gal 5:13 NASB) For you were called to freedom, brethren; only do not turn your freedom into an opportunity for the flesh, but through love **serve one another**.

(Gal 5:26 NASB) Let us **not become boastful, challenging one another, envying one another**.

(Eph 4:2 NASB) with all humility and gentleness, with patience, **showing forbearance to one another** in love,

(Eph 4:25 NASB) Therefore, **laying aside falsehood, SPEAK TRUTH, EACH ONE of you, WITH HIS NEIGHBOR**, for we are **members of one another**.

(Eph 4:32 NASB) And be **kind to one another**, tender-hearted, **forgiving each other**, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.

(Eph 5:19 NASB) **speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs**, singing and making melody with your heart to the Lord;

(Eph 5:21 NASB) and **be subject to one another** in the fear of Christ.

(Phil 2:3 NASB) Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind let each of you **regard one another as more important than himself**;

(Col 3:13 NASB) **bearing with one another, and forgiving each other**, whoever has a complaint against anyone; just as the Lord forgave you, so also should you.

(Col 3:16 NASB) Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom teaching and **admonishing one another with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs**, singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God.

(Col 3:9 NASB) **Do not lie to one another**, since you laid aside the old self with its evil practices,

(1 Th 3:12 NASB) and may the Lord cause you to **increase and abound in love for one another**, and for all men, just as we also do for you;

(1 Th 4:18 NASB) Therefore **comfort one another** with these words.

(1 Th 5:11 NASB) Therefore **encourage one another**, and build up **one another**, just as you also are doing.

(1 Th 5:13 NASB) and that you **esteem them very highly** in love because of their work. **Live in peace with one another**.

(1 Th 5:15 NASB) See that no one repays another with evil for evil, but always **seek after that which is good for one another** and for all men.

(Heb 3:13 NASB) But **encourage one another** day after day, as long as it is still called "Today," lest any one of you be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin.

(Heb 10:24 NASB) and let us consider how to **stimulate one another to love and good deeds**,

(Heb 10:25 NASB) **not forsaking our own assembling together**, as is the habit of some, but **encouraging one another**; and all the more, as you see the day drawing near.

Biblical 'one anothers'

(James 4:11 NASB) **Do not speak against one another**, brethren. He who speaks against a brother, or judges his brother, speaks against the law, and judges the law; but if you judge the law, you are not a doer of the law, but a judge of it.

(James 5:9 NASB) **Do not complain**, brethren, **against one another**, that you yourselves may not be judged; behold, the Judge is standing right at the door.

(James 5:16 NASB) Therefore, **confess your sins to one another**, and **pray for one another**, so that you may be healed. The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much.

(1 Pet 4:10 NASB) As each one has received a special gift, employ it in **servicing one another**, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

(1 Pet 4:9 NASB) **Be hospitable to one another** without complaint.

(1 Pet 5:5 NASB) You younger men, likewise, be subject to your elders; and all of you, clothe yourselves with **humility toward one another**, for **GOD IS OPPOSED TO THE PROUD, BUT GIVES GRACE TO THE HUMBLE.**

(1 John 1:7 NASB) but if we walk in the light as He Himself is in the light, we have **fellowship with one another**, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin.

Greet one another with a holy kiss

(Rom 16:16 NASB) Greet **one another** with a holy kiss. All the churches of Christ greet you.

(1 Cor 16:20 NASB) All the brethren greet you. Greet **one another** with a holy kiss.

(2 Cor 13:12 NASB) Greet **one another** with a holy kiss.

(1 Pet 5:14 NASB) Greet **one another** with a kiss of love. Peace be to you all who are in Christ.
